Elevate Montana	<p>Todd Garrison presented on the Childwise Institute, Elevate MT, and the ACES training. Todd provided a rundown on the history of his position as Director of Childwise Institute that was started through the Intermountain Children’s Home. Todd provided an Elevate MT manual for the members to review and encouraged members to become an affiliate. The Childwise Institute has planned a training trauma informed training conference, primarily for instructors for May 12th and Jim Sporleder, the principal of Lincoln High School in Walla Walla, WA will be the featured speaker. Lincoln High is where the movie, Paper Tigers was filmed. The focus of the training conference is to train instructors in creating a trauma informed classroom environment. The fee is \$200 per person and 6 OPI renewal units will be available. Todd discussed the Childwise Institute Summit coming up in September on the 28-29. The evening of the 27th will be dedicated to an event recognizing the affiliates of Elevate MT. Elevate MT and Todd promote the vision of the communities who have joined Elevate MT as the backbone of the community in wanting to provide trauma informed approaches to adolescents and others suffering from trauma. Todd discussed many of the research findings regarding the brain and the effect of traumatic experiences.</p> <p>Antonia stated since they had two missing LAC members they will discuss whether to become an affiliate at the next meeting.
